- Trekkers Helper/Leader (Children's Team)*
Helping with children's teaching and discipleship groups on Sundays as part of a team (rota basis)
 - Crawlers Helper/Leader (Creche)*
Helping set up the room and supervise babies and toddlers during Sunday services (rota basis)
 - ReGen Helper/Leader (Youth Team)*
Helping provide a programme of events and discipleship for teenagers on Sundays and other times (rota basis)
 - Small Group Leader*
Helping lead a small group to grow in missional discipleship

- Prayer Ministry Team*

- Visiting / Practical Help*
Supporting vulnerable or housebound people (e.g. visiting, cooking meals, giving lifts)

Praying for needs as they arise

- Market Place Team
Being present in Wokingham Market Place on Saturdays—engaging with people, sharing faith, offering prayer
 - Primary Schools Work*
Helping with occasional lessons or assemblies in local primary schools
 - World Mission Support
Supporting overseas mission partners through prayer and maintaining contact
 - Helping to run an Alpha Course

Resourcing & Support

- Administration
Helping with admin tasks, projects, or organising groups/events
 - Website / Social Media / Graphic Design
Helping keep communication platforms attractive and up to date
 - Maintenance (DIY)
Helping care for and maintain church buildings
 - Gardening
Helping keep the church grounds tidy (weeding, planting, mowing, pruning)

Providing sound and projection support for services and events

Welcoming guests and helping new people feel at home
- Stewarding Team
Greeting people, helping with seating and queries, and supporting practical aspects of services (rota basis)

Reading from the Bible during services
 - Flower Arranging
Providing simple floral arrangements for the sanctuary (rota basis)

Delivering simple, acted Bible story assemblies in primary schools (weekly or monthly)

Supporting people through a weekly discipleship programme addressing “hurts, habits, and hang-ups”
